# **SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP)**

## <u>Jigsaw</u>

**DO NOT** use this tool unless appropriately instructed in its safe use and operation and permission to operate has been given.

#### **COMPULSORY PPE**









## **Pre-Operational Safety Checks**

- 1. Ensure the power tool has a suitable safe work area.
- 2. Make sure the lade is intact and suits the material to be cut.
- 3. Examine the power lead and plug for obvious damage.
- 4. Plan a sawing procedure to minimise backing out.

### **Operational Safety Checks**

- 1. Examine the material to be cut for splits, loose knots and nails, etc.
- 2. Ensure the work piece is secure and well supported.
- 3. Do not plug in until all adjustments have been made.
- 4. Ensure the power cord is well clear of the blade.
- 5. Check the underside of the cut to ensure that the blade will not cause any damage or be obstructed.
- 6. Allow the machine to reach full speed before starting a cut always saw at a moderate rate.
- 7. Keep hands away from front of cutting operation.
- 8. Do not apply excessive force to the material being cut.
- 9. Take care when cutting curves to ensure that the blade does not twist or bind if necessary, drill small holes.
- 10. If the blade binds, release the switch immediately free the blade and inspect for damage.
- 11. Do not allow waste to accumulate on or around the saw blade or work piece. Ensure that off-cuts will not cause binding or fall on your feet.
- 12. On completion, wait for the blade to stop moving before lifting the jigsaw from the work piece, and then rest the saw on its side, protecting the blade.
- 13. If the blade breaks, stop sawing immediately. Switch the machine off and report it to your teacher.

## Housekeeping

- 1. Return the power tool to its correct storage cupboard.
- 2. Leave the work area in a safe, clean and tidy condition.
