SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP)

Broaching Machine

DO NOT use this tool unless appropriately instructed in its safe use and operation and permission to operate has been given.

COMPULSORY PPE







Pre-Operational Safety Checks

- 1. Ensure no slip/trip hazards are present in workspaces and walkways.
- 2. If the job obstructs the walkway erect a barricade.
- 3. Follow correct clamping procedures to ensure work is secure.
- 4. Faulty equipment must not be used. Immediately report to your supervisor.

Operational Safety Checks

- 1. Make sure proper bushings and dowels are used with proper parts.
- 2. Make sure tooling is correct for type of job being performed.
- 3. Make sure you use the broaching shaft correctly.
- 4. Use proper cutting fluid when broaching.
- 5. Practise good housekeeping.
- 6. Don't try and modify the broaching machine in anyway.
- 7. Never leave the broach shaft in an unsafe place where it can be damaged.
- 8. Never leave this or any machine unattended. Always turn off the power when not in use.

Housekeeping

- 1. Return all tooling and fixture to the correct storage location.
- 2. Leave the equipment and work area in a safe, clean and tidy state.
- 3. Return surplus material to stock and dispose of water material in an appropriate recycling or waste bin.

Potential Hazards

- Moving parts
- 2. Sharp edges & burrs
- 3. Squash/crush and pinch points
- 4. Flying debris
- 5. Eye injuries

SPECIAL NOTES

No personnel are to use this equipment prior to obtaining:

- Competency in the correct use of the equipment
- Reading and fully understanding the operator's manual can be located in the Recopak Manuals Draw (marked on Recopak Map)
- Reading the standard operating procedure
